Training: Project Transformation House Chaplains must attend and assist with AmeriCorps Member training during May 21st – July 27th, 2012.

Typical Day: Project Transformation camps run Monday-Thursday from 9:00-3:00 starting June 4th through July 27th. House Chaplains are expected to visit each of the sites in their program city at least once a week or as needed.

Living: The House Chaplain is required to live with the AmeriCorps Members in a community setting. Room and Board are provided.

Hours: House Chaplains periodically assist Project Transformation staff prepare for training during the month of May. House Chaplains are required to be on-call and available 24-7 during the months of June and July.
